Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a membercoach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. Format of Meet: This will be a Pentathlon Meet with all events conducted as a pre-seeded timed final. Facility: The ten-land pool is 25-yards with non-turbulent lane markers and backstrokes flags. Pool depth at starting end is 7-feet and the turn is 7-feet with a block height of 29.5inches (the competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2(4). Warm-ups: AM Session: 8:00 am warm-ups with a meet start at 9:05 am Estimated meet timeline will be available on the SEA website www.sea-y.org/pentahlon Wisconsin Swimming warm-up procedures will be in effect. Warm-up assignments/schedule will be posted on the meet landing page shortly after all entries are finalized. Timing System: A fully automatic Colorado timing system with two manual back-up buttons and two back-up timers for each lane will be used. If the automatic system fails, a gun or horn start will be used. General Rules: Official 2022 USA Swimming and WI LSC rules shall prevail at this meet. Age as of November 6, 2022. In granting this sanction it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming and Wisconsin Swimming, Inc., shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event. Entry Limit:	Participation is limited to a maximum of five (5) individual events.
Disabled Swimmers	: Coaches are encouraged to inform Officials and the Meet Director of any disabled swimmer's needs prior to warm-ups.
MAAPP:	Current USA Swimming Rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), will govern this meet. A registered athlete member at a sanctioned/approved meet who is 18 years of age or older, who had not completed the Athlete Protection Training (APT) by the date of the swim, will not be able to upload into SWIMS. These athletes will also be considered "not in good standing" and can be subject to fines under Wisconsin Swimming Policy 11.2.1

Format:	Individual events will be swum as combined as Senior, 12&U, and 8&U events. <u>Please note:</u> Heats/events may be combined due to time constraints. Breaks may be added at the discretion of the entry chair.
Coaches:	Coaches may pick-up heat sheets and pay any remaining balance for entry fees/submit waivers at the Scoring/Records Table. Please be prepared to show your USA coach's card or USA Swimming App credentials at this time.
Awards:	Bag Tag heat winners.

Admissions:	Included with entry fee.
Food:	Will not be offered at this event.
Conduct:	 All coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and will see that their club has proper supervision at all times. Meet Marshals have the authority to remove any swimmer and/or spectator from the meet for any violation such as improper behavior, damage to property, etc. No smoking on the premises. Please encourage your parents and swimmers to clean up after themselves. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms or locker rooms. Changing into or out of swimsuits other than locker rooms or other designated areas is prohibited. Flash photography and photography from behind the starting blocks are prohibited at the start of each race. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the competition venue. This includes pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms anytime athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.
