Eligibility: This is an approved USA Swimming meet open to all swimmers.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Format of Meet: Time final with all events pre-seeded fast to slow.

Facility: Indoor, 25-yard pool with 8-lanes. 6'7" at the start end and 7' at the turn end. Starting blocks are 29.5". The Competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2 C (4).

Warm-ups: AM Sessions: 9:00 a.m. warm-ups with a meet start of 10:35 a.m.

Wisconsin Swimming warm-up procedures will be in effect. Warm-up assignments/schedule will be posted on the meet landing page shortly after all entries are finalized. A maximum of four swimmers per lane during warm-up (two on each side).

Timing System: A fully automatic combination of SST and Colorado timing system with one manual back-up button and one back-up timer for each lane will be used. If the automatic system fails, a gun or horn start will be used.

General Rules: Official 2021 USA Swimming and WI LSC rules shall prevail at this meet. Age as of January 16, 2021. In granting this sanction it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming and Wisconsin Swimming, Inc., shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.

- Entry Deadline:** Entry deadline is January 10, 2021 (will include entry file and PDF of entries). Please forward waivers and payment on the day of the meet (or mail prior if you prefer) to:

- Entry Fees:** \$40.00 for one day, \$64 for two days (covers all events, \$4.00 WI LSC Splash Fee, and \$12.00 WSAC user fee). Checks payable to “SEA.”
- Entry Limit:** Participation is limited to a maximum of six (6) individual events (3 per day) and relays.
- Disabled Swimmers:** Coaches are encouraged to inform Officials and the Meet Director of any disabled swimmer’s needs prior to warm-ups.
- MAAPP:** All applicable adults participating or associated with respective meet to which this information applies, acknowledge that they are an applicable adult, subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (“MAAPP”), and that they understand the compliance with the MAAPP Policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. Effective 11/6/2019 times achieved by an athlete member at a sanctioned meet who is over 18 years of age (+30 day grace period) who had not completed the Athlete Protection Training (or whose APT training had expired) by the date of the swim, will not be able to be uploaded to the SWIMS.
- Deck Entries:** Currently not allowed per USA Swimming rules.
- Format:** Individual events will be swum as Senior, 12&U, and 8&U events. Please note: Heats/events may be combined due to time constraints. Breaks may be added at the discretion of the entry chair.
- Coaches:** Coaches may pick-up heat sheets and pay any remaining balance for entry fees/submit waivers in the office. Coaches will confirm their coaching status via email prior to the meet.
- Awards:** 1st-16th ribbons for 12&U events.
- Heat Sheets:** Available for free on the meet landing page, www.sea-y.org/pentathlon.
- Admissions:** Spectators not allowed at this event.
- Food:** Will not be offered at this event.
- Conduct:** All coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and will see that their club has proper supervision at all times. Meet Marshals have the authority to remove any swimmer and/or spectator from the meet for any violation such as improper behavior, damage to property, etc. No smoking on the premises. Please encourage your parents and swimmers to clean up after themselves.
- Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms or locker rooms.
 - Changing into or out of swimsuits other than locker rooms or other designated areas is prohibited.
 - Flash photography and photography from behind the starting blocks are

prohibited at the start of each race.

- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the competition venue. This includes pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms anytime athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior approval by the Program Operations Vice Chair. 103.13M/Drones.

First Aid: Report injuries to the Lifeguard and Meet Director. First aid kit is located at the Lifeguard stand.

Lost & Found: An area for lost and found will be designated at the meet. After the meet, lost and found items will be donated to charity.

Covid Guidelines: These guidelines are for an approved swim meet using semi-automatic timing competing in eight of the 16 available competition lanes and manual back-up timing using ten of the ten available competition lanes. The competition pool is a 2x8 lane 25-yard indoor pool.

Pool Capacity: Sessions are limited to 185 athletes. If projected number of participants, coaches, officials, and workers is close to these number entries will stop being accepted. There is ample deck space to maintain 6-foot distancing. Face masks are required.

Health Monitoring: It is expected that all swimmers, coaches, officials, and volunteers are Covid symptom free and without known contact with someone with Covid symptoms or diagnosis within the last two weeks. Please do not attend the meet if you are not feeling well.
