The deadline to sign-up for the final Conference Meet of this season is tomorrow! The final Conference Meet will take place on Sunday, February 7 in Lake Geneva.

We will be hosting one more meet this season on the weekend of March 13-14; Wisconsin YMCA Regionals. This event will probably be held at Aug. Prep. More information will be coming along in the next few weeks. This meet is the last chance for YMCA State qualifying times and is open to all swimmers. Take advantage!
