Hugo Arteaga, fifth fastest 12-year-old in the 50 Freestyle at 23.18, sixth fastest in the 100 Freestyle at 52.71, sixth fastest in the 50 Butterfly at 26.03, sixth fastest in the 100 Butterfly at 57.95, sixth fastest in the 100 IM at 1:00.12, and seventh fastest in the 50 Backstroke at 27.66.

Zack Kopsea, seventh fastest 13-yearold in the 1000 Freestyle at 10:27.83.
