We'll be racing at the RecPlex in Kenosha this weekend (Friday-Sunday). There are assigned warm-ups for Saturday and Sunday ... please be on time.

Friday warm-ups run 4:00-5:00 PM, meet begins at 5:05 PM and is scheduled to end at 6:16 PM.

Saturday AM (12&U) warm-ups run 8:00-8:30 AM, meet begins at 8:35 AM and is scheduled to end at 11:07 AM

Saturday PM (13&O) warm-ups run 11:15-11:45 AM, meet begins at 12:30 PM and is scheduled to end at 4:21 PM.

Sunday AM (12&U) warm-ups run 7:30-8:00 AM, meet begins at 8:35 AM and is scheduled to end at 10:53 AM.

Sunday PM (13&O) warm-ups run 11:30 AM-Noon, meet begins at 12:05 PM and is scheduled to end at 3:19 PM.

Lakeside Invite Highlights & Recap

Traditionally this trip and meet has been a great team bonding experience for our members and this year was no different. As a team, we posted 28% best times (43 of 152 swims) and eight DQs (four Breaststroke, three Butterfly, and one false start on Freestyle).

Although our best time percentage was lower than normal, the memories of racing at this facility will last a life time and when everyone's swim careers are finishes, we won't remember the times and meets, but the fun times and friendships built over the years.

We did post a few new State qualifying times ... Hugo Arteaga in the 200 Butterfly, Jack Borzynski in the 200 Breaststroke, and Jordan Borzynski in the 100 Backstroke. Notching some of the fastest times in our team's history were Hugo Arteaga 3rd 400 Freestyle, 2nd 200 Freestyle, 3rd 200 Butterfly, Jack Borzynski 5th 400 IM, 8th 200 Backstroke, 8th 200 Breaststroke, and Evan Steenrod 6th 50 Freestyle, 9th 50 Butterfly.

Dropping five of more seconds in a single event included Hugo Arteaga -29.76 200 Butterfly, Jack Borzynski -20.83 400 Freestyle, Fiona Marini -5.77 100 Breaststroke, Sophia Marini -7.24 100 Breaststroke, Evan Steenrod -6.26 50 Butterfly, Nate Steenrod -31.85 100 Freestyle, Charlotte Wright -15.19 100 Backstroke, and Vivienne Yanke -5.76 100 Butterfly.

We hope everyone had a great experience during the meet!

Off-Season Training (OST)

OST will be offered between the end of the Spring & Summer and the beginning of the Fall & Winter Season.

OST is an opportunity for our athletes to "bridge the gap" between seasons. It allows them to keep a feel for the water during the offseason and gives them an opportunity to really focus on the little things that make for fast swimming (starts, breakouts, turns, and finishes). OST will be offered for five weeks (Monday-Wednesday, August 1-August 31) and will be led by Coach Joanna.

Gold and Senior will swim 7:00-8:30 AM and Silver and Bronze will swim 8:30-9:30 AM with each week covering starts, breakouts, turns, and finishes for one stroke.

The cost for Gold & Senior is \$150 for all five weeks or \$30 per week.

The cost for Bronze & Silver is \$100 for all five weeks or \$20 per week.
