This evening we will conclude our Spring & Summer Season with one final PM practice at Horlick. OST begins Monday and runs Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday at the Johnson Aquatic Center and finishes up on August 29. New for 2020 Summer Season – at last Monday's Parent Board meeting, it was decided to scale back the number of practices offered for Bronze and Silver swimmers. Years ago, we lost use of all three high schools at RUSD during the summer. As a way to lessen that impact, AM practices were offered for Bronze and Silver since all practices during the PM were moved to Carthage College. Prior to this, Bronze and Silver never practiced during the AM practices in the Summer. Now that RUSD has been leaving at least one pool open during the summer, we can begin to cut back the AM practices for Bronze and Silver. For 2020, Bronze and Silver will have AM practices offered on Tuesday and Thursday. Please reach out to me if you need additional information in regards to this topic.

13&O State Meet Information

Beginning tomorrow and running through Sunday we will be racing in Brown Deer during this summer's 13&O State Championships!

Warm-ups are assigned in nature and during our team meeting this morning we discussed the possibility of swimmers warming-up at Sealed Air YMCA prior to arriving in Brown Deer if their first event is later in the session. If in doubt, please contact Coach Neil at 262.994.3157 (otherwise, be behind the block five minutes prior to our warm-up period beginning).

Thursday Prelims: lane 5, 8:05-8:30 AM, meet begins 9:00 AM Friday Prelims: lane 1, 7:40-8:05 AM, meet begins 9:00 AM Saturday Prelims: lane 2, 7:40-8:05 AM, meet begins at 9:00 AM Sunday Prelims: lane 6, 7:15-7:40 AM, meet begins at 9:00 AM Thursday-Saturday Finals begin at 5:30 PM and Sunday Finals begin at 5:00 PM. Swimmers moving through to Finals should check with Coach Neil on what time to return for warm-ups.

Time final events include the 400 Freestyle, 800 Freestyle, and 400 IM. Swimmers seeded in the top 8 for 13-14 and the top 16 for Senior will race during Finals. Nathan Mudry will be racing the 400 IM during the Final session. All other time final events will race during Prelims.

All races 200-meters and less will race in Prelims with the top 16 13-14 swimmers moving to Finals and the top 32 Senior swimmers moving to Finals.
