13&O State Recap & Highlights

Solid results during 13&O State this summer. As a team we posted 76% best times for our individual events, 78% best times for our relay events, posted zero DQs and finished 21st of 44 teams in attendance scoring 128-points.

Ale Arteaga punched her ticket to Zones in the 50 Freestyle during time trials posting a 29.29 final time.

New State qualifying times were turned in by Ryan McGillis Senior 200 Backstroke 2:23.04 and Kaylee Staniger 13-14 100 Breaststroke 1:24.41, 100 Freestyle 1:05.71.

New team records were set by the quartet of Ryan McGillis, Nathaniel Foster, Jack Borzynski, and Nathan Breit in five 17-18 relays: 200 Freestyle 1:40.59, 400 Freestyle 3:45.44, 800 Freestyle 8:26.91, 200 Medley 1:51.87, and 400 Medley 4:12.60.

Posting some of the fastest times in our team history were Ale Arteaga 13-14 8th 50 Freestyle 29.29, Jack Borzynski 17-18 6th 50 Freestyle 24.93, 2nd 200 Freestyle 1:59.61, 3rd 100 Butterfly 57.55, 5th 400 Freestyle 4:29.53, 4th 100 Freestyle 54.32, Nathan Breit 17-18 9th 50 Freestyle 25.61, 10th 100 Butterfly 1:01.52, 5th 200 Backstroke 2:18.42, 4th 100 Backstroke 1:03.03, Nathaniel Foster 17-18 8th 400 Freestyle 4:34.65, Ashlyn Malzewski 17-18 6th

50 Freestyle 28.65, 10th 200 Freestyle 2:23.28, 8th 100 Freestyle 1:03.53, Ryan McGillis 17-18 6th 200 Backstroke 2:23.04, 6th 100 Backstroke 1:03.98, and Kaylee Staniger 13-14 9th 100 Breaststroke 1:24.41.

Cutting five or more seconds in an event included Nathaniel Foster -10.28 400 Freestyle, Ava Kerbawy -14.76 100 Butterfly, and Ryan McGillis -5.23 200 Backstroke.

Posting 100% best times were Ava Kerbawy, Ashlyn Malzewski, Ryan McGillis, and Kaylee Staniger.

Off-Season Training Available in August

Off-Season Training (OST) will be offered between the end of the Spring & Summer Season and the beginning of the Fall & Winter Season.

OST is an opportunity for our athletes to "bridge the gap" between seasons. It allows them to keep a feel for the water during the offseason and affords them the opportunity to really focus on the little things that make for fast swimming (starts, breakouts, turns, and finishes).

OST will be offered for four weeks (Monday-Wednesday, August 4-27 and be led by Coach Parker. Gold and Senior will swim 7:00-8:30 AM and Bronze and Silver will swim 8:30-9:30 AM with each week covering starts, breakouts, turns, and finishes for one stroke (the order by weeks is Freestyle, Backstroke, Breaststroke, Butterfly).

The cost for Gold and Senior is \$160 for all four weeks or \$40 per week.

The cost for Bronze and Silver is \$120 for all four weeks or \$30 per week.

All practices will be held at the outdoor SCJ Community pool and all participants will need a membership to the pool (secure at the front desk at the facility, \$25). There will be no refunds or "make-up days" for inclement weather/canceled practices.

If practice needs to be canceled because of thunder or lightening, a Facebook notification will be posted at 6:00 AM for Gold and Senior practice and 7:00 AM for Bronze and Silver.

If you plan on attending, simply attend the week(s) you would like to train at and forward payment to Coach Parker when you show-up. Take advantage!
