Welcome back TEAM SEA! Man, was our day one crazy busy or what? Must be the Olympic year bump. Regardless, don't let how busy we are jade your impression of what we do here at TEAM SEA. We have options if our numbers ballon over 105+ swimmers. We will monitor attendance during the next two to three weeks and make a decision on any necessary changes after we see how sign-ups and attendance shakes out.

We already have a meet deadline! As usual, our first meet of the new season sees us heading to Mequon for OZ's Fall Classic. The meet runs October 11-13. Entry deadline is September 30. Email me if you would like to have your swimmer entered in the meet. This is a USA Swimming sanctioned event and all swimmers attending must have a current USA Swimming Membership.

Tonight is Case High School's Homecoming football game and shockingly, attendees have been instructed to park in the Aquatic Center's parking lot. Please note, parking will be an issue this evening.

Here are a few helpful reminders as we dip into our new season: never drop your swimmer off at practice without ensuring a SEA coach is on deck, unless your swimmer brings a lock to practice, all items should be stored on deck - never leave bags/clothes/gear in the locker room unless it is locked up, swimmers will exit the locker rooms 15-minutes after the conclusion of their practice, if you are dropping off your swimmers for practice early, they should sit on the pool deck or in the stands and quietly read, do their homework, chat with friends, or anything else that does not include horseplay, running, climbing, etc., and families are welcome to watch practice for the balconies - do not sit on deck.

Communication is the most important trait here at TEAM SEA. Families should never be confused about anything swim team related. If you have a question, please contact me. We

are here for our swimmers, but also our parents. We have your back!

This is going to be a great year and our coaching staff is excited for another season of growth and development!

13&O State Recap & Highlights

TEAM SEA had a strong showing at this summer's 13&O State Championships even though our numbers were small, our swims were BIG. We finished 16th overall in Division 2 with 50-points (29th out of all teams in Wisconsin). Our swimmers posted 73% best times and no DQs.

Our top finish came in the 100 Freestyle where Brady Moore finished 3rd overall. His 200 Freestyle time was also a YMCA National qualifying time.

New team records were posted by Brady in the Senior 200 Freestyle, 1:58.77 (old record was held by Hugo Arteaga, 1:59.94 from 2022). Jack Borzynski broke the 15-16 200 Freestyle

record with his effort of 1:59.55 (also breaking Hugo's 15-16 record from 2022, 1:59.94).

Athletes posting some of the fastest times in our team's history included Ale Arteaga 13-14 4th 100 Butterfly 1:12.96, Jack Borzynski 15-16 2nd 1500 Freestyle 17:42.10, Nathan Breit 15-16 5th 50 Freestyle 25.52, 4th 200 Freestyle 2:04.39, 6th 100 Butterfly 1:01.95, 2nd 200 Backstroke 2:17.14, 5th 100 Freestyle 56.09, Lindsey Hohnl 15-16 8th 100 Breaststroke 1:22.93, Ryan McGillis 15-16 9th 100 Backstroke 1:06.16, and Brady Moore 17-18 2nd 50 Freestyle 24.26, 2nd 100 Freestyle 52.94.

Posting 100% best times were Lindsey Hohnl and Ryan McGillis.

Dropping five or more seconds in an event included Lindsey Hohnl -6.39 in the 200 Breaststroke and Ryan McGillis -13.16 in the 400 Freestyle.
